



Russ Melichar Retires


Wisconsin Division 40 Years of Service

Wisconsin Division Signal Maintainer **Russell J. Melichar** retired on December 30, 2008. **Russ** hired out on the C&NW in 1968 as a Signal Maintainer Helper out of Butler, Wisconsin. A few years later, he was promoted as Assistant Signal Maintainer at St. Francis. Then in 1974, he was promoted to Signal Maintainer at West Allis, Wisconsin. **Russ** was the last signal maintainer to work out of the West Allis depot before it closed in 1977. After the depot closed, he returned to St. Francis for a few years and then transferred to Butler, remaining there until his retirement. **Russ** worked 40 years without an injury. In November 2008, **Russ** was voted employee of the month for the Chicago service unit. **Russ** now plans to go hunting, fishing and spend time with his grand kids. He is also planning an Amtrak trip to Texas with his wife Sharon to visit friends.
